PLANNING could soon be under way to bring new life back to the dead heart of Murwillumbah – the partly deserted and abandoned

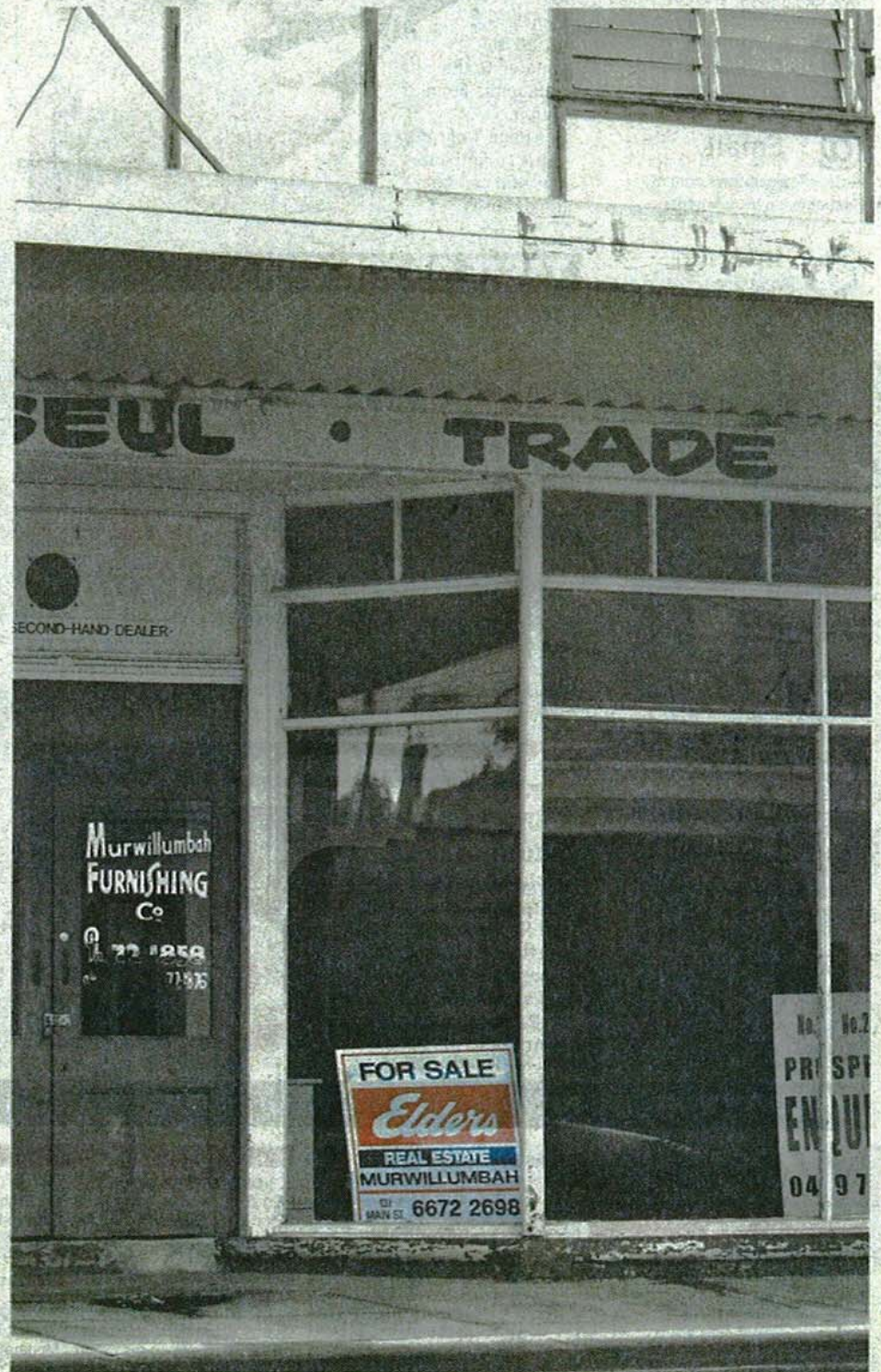
stretch of Prospero Street which for many years was a major business hub.
